Background

The Coolbinia Bombers Junior Football Club committee in consultation with the wider club community have established a dress code for our playing groups, Year 3 and above.

The purpose of the dress code is to represent the CBJFC in a professional and identifiable way whilst contributing to a sense of community within the club.

The following dress standards apply to players and coaches for Match Days or when representing the Club during organised functions or activities.

Year 3 – 7 (Modified Teams)

- Playing shorts (Club provided)
- Football socks (Club provided)
- Club shirt / Hoodie or Jacket. (Club provided)

Years 8 – 12 (Youth Teams)

- Club shirt / Hoodie or Jacket. (Club provided)
- Black dress trousers/pants (NOT jeans) **
- Black shoes (preferable)

*** Youth girl's pants to be advised by Team manager in consultation with the Committee prior to each season.*

Coaching Volunteers

- Club Shirt (club provided)
- **** Youth Coaches** – In line with the Youth player dress code it is requested black trousers/pants be worn on game day and at Club or District events.
