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# VOLUNTEERING

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### Background

The Coolbinia Bombers JFC is a volunteer run organisation and in order for games and training sessions to be able to operate efficiently, we require parent volunteers throughout the club on a roster basis. No special skills or knowledge is necessary, but parent help is viewed as a compulsory element of membership of our club.

### Member Obligations:

To ensure that all children have a safe and rewarding learning experience, it is mandatory for one parent / carer from each family to assist in some form of Volunteering over the course of each season.

Volunteering may take a variety of forms including but not limited to - Coaching, Managing, Officiating, First Aid, BBQ and Canteen duties, or participation on our Committee.

The Club commits to work with families and their individual circumstances, but all members agree they will make every effort to participate in our Volunteering rosters whenever requested.

### Non-Compliance

The Coolbinia Bombers JFC has a policy that should a Parent or Family not participate or fail to fulfil their volunteer roster obligations, the Club may at its discretion take various actions as deemed appropriate by the Management Committee.

These actions include but are not limited to;

- A player may forfeit their rights to any Trophies, Awards, Team photos or other Club provided item(s).
- A player may be excluded from competition and special events such as half time AFL games and activities.
- Ongoing refusal may see membership to the club permanently revoked.
