CLUB CAPTAINS

Background

Annually the Coolbinia Bombers JFC Management Committee endorses the appointment of Team Captains in all Male and Female Youth Teams. The Management Committee will further consider players elected as Team Captains, or from within Team leadership roles, for the position of CBJFC Club Captain(s).

Selection Process

Prior to the commencement of the season, the Coaches Coordinator or President shall circulate a request for applications nominating players to the role of Club Captain.

Nominations received will be considered by the Management Committee.

Eligibility and Attributes

The position of Club Captain is a prestigious role.

Club Captain(s) would normally be the Team Captain or a Leadership Group Member from the Clubs most senior Team(s) and whenever possible, the roles will be held by 1 x Male and 1 x Female player.

Awarding of these titles remains at the absolute discretion of the Management Committee from year to year. A Club Captain may hold the title for more than 1 year, however it is required they be nominated and receive subsequent endorsement each and every year.

If deemed appropriate by the Management Committee, either the Male or Female Club Captain position may be left vacant for a period of time.

If the most Senior Team is playing within a merged or combined team and the Captain of such a team is not a Coolbinia Bombers registered player, then the CBJFC Club Captain, may be selected from other Coolbinia Bombers registered players within that team, or from another Youth team at the Club.

In endorsing a player as Club Captain, the following attributes must be considered:

- The nominee must be a registered player at the Coolbinia Bombers JFC for at least 2 years (this period may include the year of appointment as a year of registration).
- The player must have shown the ability and skills to be an ambassador for the Club's Codes of Conduct.
- The player must be approachable, reliable and trustworthy with high expectations of themselves and others.
- The player must have the respect of their team-mates and Coaches.
- The player must have demonstrated leadership abilities on and off the playing field.

The Management Committees may revoke a player's appointment as Club Captain if their behaviour is not consistent with the Club's expected standards and Codes of Behaviour.

Roles and Responsibilities of the Club Captains

The Club Captain will be expected to take an active interest in all areas of the Coolbinia Bombers Junior Football Club.

This may include;

- Attending Committee Meetings or providing feedback or input to the President or a delegate of the Clubs Management Committee.
- Prepare a written Club Captain report to be included in the Clubs Annual Report.
- Assist and Speak at Club functions such as Trophy Night and other special events.

The Club understands and acknowledges that fulfilling the responsibilities as Club Captain will always be secondary to schooling and education commitments as well as team commitments such as training and game-days.
