#### PRESIDENTS REPORT 1976

Mr Barry O'Mahoney, the Club Secretary, resigned from his position with the 'Golden Fleece' organisation to take on his own service station and thus found that his time availability was greatly restricted.

Finally my own and the clubs congratulations to Jamie Daniels, the Presidents Trophy winner and to all other trophy winners for really trying and playing "the game".

The 1976 season left little to enthuse about with only 2 wins, (both against the same team).


Although we consistently had 24 to 26 boys at each game only 4 had played football prior to this season.

#### Under 12's Team Coach Report



The voting this year was excellent and many players picked up votes.




#### Under 16's Team Coach Report

#### Under 18's Team Coach Report


The season began on a bright note, with two wins in pre-season matches.
