


With help from the Mums and Dads the boys have shown a considerable amount of dedication and application in their approach to our national game and I am pleased to have had their young ones under my control.


We saw the 1986 season end on a high note with a successful win against Morley P.C.Y.C.



The Neville Reynolds Trophy commenced in 1982 and is in recognition of Mr. Neville Reynolds, the man whose idea it was to start Coolbinia-Yokine Junior Football Club.

This prestige's award is to the player who is not necessarily the best footballer but one who has put himself out to improve his football skills and has shown through his character and actions that he has his Club at heart. In plainer terms he is our Club's Best Player Representative.

The points through which this award has been chosen are quite stringent and a player must qualify on all points to be considered.

The seven points which qualify a nominee are as follows:-

- 1. Should have attended training regularly.
- 2. Receptive and willing to co-operate at training.
- 3. Respectful to his Coach and Parents and Club Officials.
- 4. Does not have to be asked twice to help.
- 5. Should attend all functions at East perth i.e. Junior Parade, Raffle day etc.
- 6. Loyal Club member (i.e. Willing to offer assistance to coaches).
- 7. Not to be brought up before the East Perth Protests and Disputes Board.

And then the resultant qualifying nominees are voted upon by the Executive Committee.

The award this year has been won by David Fisher who has always been willing to assist whenever called upon, he never misses training and is a coaches ideal young boy to coach.
