PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Members may not be aware but the club initiated a subcommitte of Mr Tom O'Farrell and Charles Musca to discuss the possibility of an amalgamation with the Dianella Football Club. At this point in time no formal recommendations have been proposed by this Clubs Committee. It appears a decision will not be made until early 1988.

To all Committee members may I thank them for their efforts throughout the season, a special note of thanks to Dianne Melvin and Tom O'Farrell for their untiring work.

SOCIAL - all teams enjoyed players teas or barbecues throughout the season, and the drink of cordial after each training session which was kindly donated by Harry Bozin of Quick Stop Bassendean was greatly appreciated by all, thanks on behalf of the club.

Although the social evening held by the Club for parents was poorly attended, those who did attend thoroughly enjoyed themselves, thanks to Reg Beall and his lovely music.

In closing, I would like to thank my wife, Carol for her assistance and support.

The Club is in a very sound financial position and when the Amateurs do move across to their new premises it is envisaged to carry out some improvements to our social and change rooms.

Our association with the amateur club this year has been extremely amicable and they are very keen to maintain a good relationship with the view of eventually having the services of young players as they progress out of junior football. A special mention must also be made of their kind offer of three Eagles jumpers to be awarded to one lucky boy from each team.

Whilst on awards the club this year has followed the W.A.N.F.L. policy of not providing trophies to boys playing modified football. The emphasis is now being placed on team participation, not winning premierships and being warded trophies to a limited number. Each boy is to receive an "Aussie Footy" Skill Certificate Award.

Due to work and Council committments, this will be my last President's report. I would like to thank those people that have helped me in both my capacity as a coach and President. I have thoroughly enjoyed my 7 years with the club.

Although I am standing down I hope to be elected to Committee to assist wherever possible.

And then the resultant qualifying nominees are voted upon by the Executive Committee.
