

### **AUSKICK SUMMARY**

We had 79 kids for the season which is great for our club and football's future.

The season has been a very productive one and on reflection looking at the kids progress is very satisfying especially the 5/6 year olds, the young girls and the couple of kids in general who until this year had never picked up a footy. Well done on your efforts. For the older kids who have been around the club this their second or third year your skills have also been great to watch and the way you have set an example for the younger kids with the enthusiasm and positive attitude that you've shown throughout the year. Well done.

The season began the first Sunday after the April school holidays in which approx 60 kids were involved. A "parents in service" session with Mr Gavin Rose our East Perth District Junior Officer. The parents were shown a few tricks with a footy and a few laughs were had by all. We also held the club's family fun day.

The next few weeks the kids were split into groups and were shown the basic fundamentals of our game and played some grid games against each other. On Mother's Day, the mums where made to form a circle and kids surprised them all with a chocolate. The looks on the mum's faces were just great.

We had our first outing in June when we played on Leederville Oval at the half time break of the East Perth v Claremont league match. 50 kids played in the rain. The air of nervous anticipation amongst the players was exciting and the proud look in their eyes as they ran onto the oval was something to remember. The fifteen odd minutes we had to play our game seemed to go forever, yet when the siren went it was a sudden "oh we've just started" feeling. Once back in the rooms however, the kids were quite satisfied with their efforts and thrilled for the opportunity to play on the "Big Boys" turf. A good afternoon had by all.

The following weekend we were privileged to have players from the Essendon Football Club down at the club. Mark Johnson, Joel Reynolds and Jason Winderlich helped out with training drills with approx 30 Auskick kids, then took part in an autograph session. Our club received Australia-wide exposure with channel 7 and 10 taking footage and showing it on their sport news that night. The Community Newspapers also had a photo and write-up.

We had our first "FOOTY BUS TRIP" to Bayswater Bears for a round robin morning against 4 other clubs. About 55 to 60 kids from Bombers participated on a cold but sunny morning. They played 5 games each but as the morning went on, the little kids were tuckered out and just couldn't see out the last game.

The next few weeks we continued with training drills and were involved in the East Perth district Junior day parade. The kids marched onto Leederville oval in front of a large crowd to parade the colours of the club. We then travelled to Nollamara and played a grid game against Cougars and Balga football clubs.

At the end of July our kids were invited to be a part of East Perth's Centenary Year celebrations with a training and grid game exhibition on Leederville Oval. This ended with a sausage sizzle and some giveaways and a photo with a legend of football in W A - Mal Brown, and the current coach of East Perth, Warren Mahoney,

The 8's ventured into new territory and played a grid game against Cardinals at their ground and accounted for themselves magnificently with a great display of teamwork and some individual passages of play they would be proud of.

We then hosted Cougars, Balga and a few kids from Morley Bulldogs at our ground. With some training drills and a grid game lots of fun had by all.

Our 2<sup>nd</sup> last training will finish off with a twilight training and grid game under lights in which the kids will love. Our season will culminate with a presentation day windup which will start with a grid game to finish off the season.
