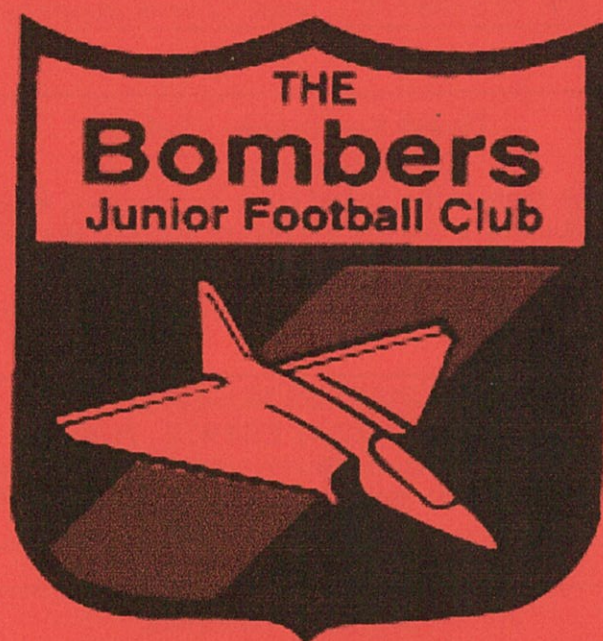

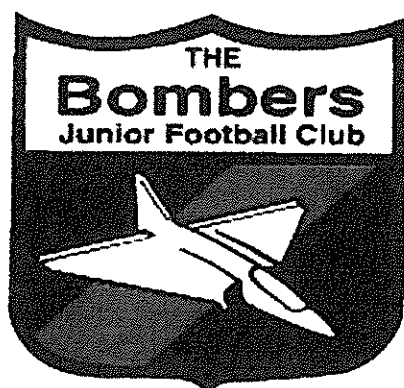

All teams performed admirably this year with all four youth teams making the finals. Unfortunately the 14s and 17s bowed out early in the final series with the 14s suffering a nail biting 1 point loss. The 15s were preliminary finalists, however our 13s played their first grand final going on to win the premiership defeating the Cougars 4:10 – 4:5.

This year we also had many players selected for elite development squads with Peter Athanasiou's (15s) been rewarded with selection in the State schoolboys team which played in Darwin this year.

Special thanks to all our coaches who have performed admirably in getting all our teams to the finals. Well done to Laurie Hart as a first year coach and getting his 13's to the Grand Final, and likewise to Kelvin Sharp who continues to learn and develop as a coach and was rewarded with a preliminary final for his 15s.

Special thanks also to Graham Begg 14s who after four years leaves the coaching ranks and despite a heartbreaking loss in the finals still has the distinction of being a premiership coach when he took his then 13s team to the 2005 flag. Everyone knows how hard Graham has worked with his team and what he has accomplished. The club wishes him all the best for the future.

To Leo Schaafsma who endured a frustrating season, with his 17s often having to deal with player shortages due to absences, injuries and unavailability of several key players. We thank him for his hard work and dedication and hope he continues in the coaching sphere as he still has 'unfinished business'.

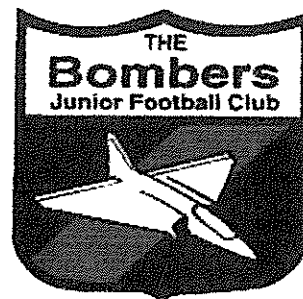

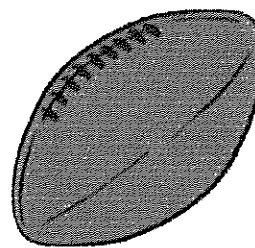

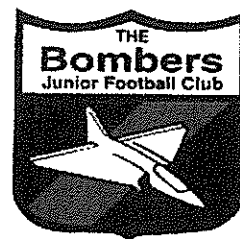

This award recognises the excellent example that Kadin has set both off the field with his superb application at training, and on the field where he has become a very accountable high possession winner.

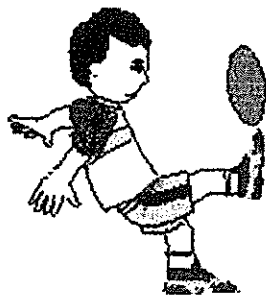

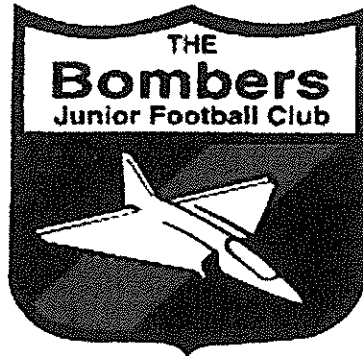
